## Dress Code Requirements

Tops & Straps	Bottom & Length	General Requirements
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All tops must have straps that are at least 2 finger widths wide</li><li>• Spaghetti straps are not permitted</li><li>• Midriffs must be fully covered, with no exposed abdomen area</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shorts, Skirts &amp; Dresses must reach your fingertips when your arms are at your side</li><li>• Any holes in clothing must be below fingertip length to be considered appropriate</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Undergarments should never be visible</li><li>• Remember that you are not just representing yourself, but SLHE, and all homeschoolers, when attending our events</li></ul>
