- And much more!

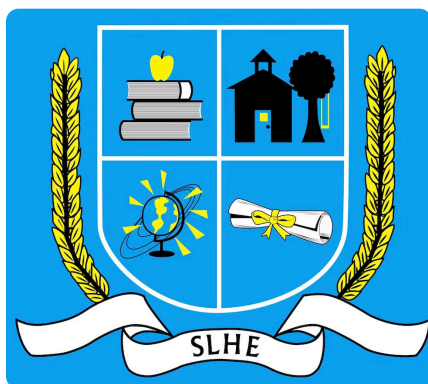
Our Co-op Is One Part of the Bigger Picture
